Introduced Species vs Invasive Species
All invasive species are introduced, but
not all introduced species are invasive.
Introduced species: Brought to a place by
humans

What makes an introduced species invasive?

Invasive species: Non-native (or alien) to the ecosystem *and* whose introduction causes or is likely to cause economic or environmental harm or harm to **human health**.

Invasive species are an animal, plant or bacteria that moves into an ecosystem, "invade". It is always introduced by humans.

They have no natural predator and it often unbalances the ecosystem

In some places it kills off or crowds out the native species or completely replaces it, in that ecosystem.
